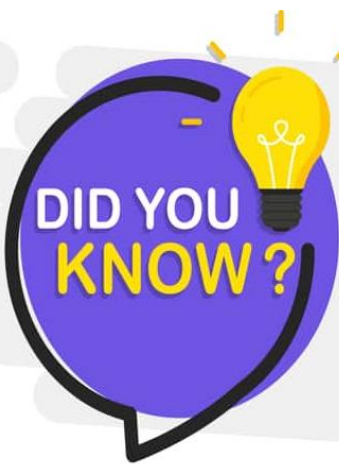

Tribal Students

For the **Fall 2024** school semester, any student who wishes to **be funded** for the education scholarship must apply by **Friday August 16th**.

The items that are required include:

1. Two-page tribal application; the second page must be filled out by a financial aid officer.
2. Previous semester's grades if you are a continuing student.
3. Current semester's class schedule.
4. If you are a new student, you must provide your high school diploma as well as your college acceptance letter.
